Dear Park Owner/Operator:

Thank you for submitting your park's Emergency Preparedness Plan to the Department of Housing and Community Development (Department) for review.

Recent legislation (Senate Bill 23, Chapter 551, Statutes of 2009) amended the Health and Safety Code and required all parks, regardless of size to have an Emergency Preparedness Plan. The Emergency Preparedness Plan must be specific to each individual park and must either adopt the plans and procedures contained in the *Emergency Plans for Mobilehome Parks* booklet developed by the California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA) or consist of a plan comparable to the plans and procedures contained in that booklet.

After review of your park's proposed plan the Department has determined that it is consistent with the minimum criteria required to be comparable to the plans and procedures contained in the *Emergency Plans for Mobilehome Parks* booklet.

The Department will maintain a record of the plan and there is no need to submit additional plans in the future unless conditions within the park change. However, it is highly recommended that you keep the general information in your plan up-to-date if the need arises.
